
Most water use and waste occurs outdoors!

We can make a big impact in the amount of water we use everyday by making some simple changes. Take the following actions to see how much water you can spare each day.



SAVE EVEN MORE!



Reduce outdoor watering during fall and winter months to one day per week (Saturday or Sunday).



Water with the weather.

If rain is in the forecast, be sure to turn-off sprinklers for one week.



Capture shower or bathtub warm-up water and use it to water trees and landscape plants.




CHECK THE SOIL

Use a screwdriver to check six inches deep near the drip line - if soil is wet or sticky, allow to dry before watering again.
